

Lebanon Or December 15<sup>th</sup> 1891

Council met in regular session Roll called and members all present

Minutes of the last regular meeting read and approved

The final report of L Foley Street-Commissioner read and on motion of C H Ralston was accepted and ordered to be placed on file

He then presented his resignation and on motion of Jos Elkins was accepted

The Report of the Canvassers of the Election was read and on motion of G W Crusan the report was accepted and the Recorder was authorized to issue certificates to parties according to the report of the Canvassers

Bill No 21 was then read the first time and on motion of G W Crusan was read the second time by title and referred to Ordinance Committee for amendment

Bill No 22 was read the first time and on Motion of C H Ralston was read the second time by title and referred to Committee on Ordinances for amendment

Bill No 20 was then read the third time and recommitted to the Committee for amendment

By motion of C H Ralston, the Recorder was authorized to draw on the City Treasurer for twelve dollars and pay the expenses of election

By motion the Road and Street fund was turned into the general fund for the purpose of replacing what was used from the general fund in the Road & Streets

The Bill of G W W<sup>rd</sup> Bride in regard to certified Copy of Charter was laid on the Table, by motion of G W Crusan

The Committee on A/c<sup>ts</sup> & Current expenses reported favorable on the Bills of P M Smith and Swan Bros, and the Recorder was ordered to draw warrants on the Treasurers for the same

All Bills presented before the Council were referred to Committee with instructions to report at next meeting of Council

Council then adjourned to meet on next Friday evening Dec 18<sup>th</sup> to transact unfinished business and all new that might come up
