

Lebanon Or December 18th 1891

Council met pursuant to adjournment
Roll called and Members all present

The Report of the Engineer E f O'Connor
on the Drain from the McCalley property to
S. A. Wickerson was read and on motion of
C H Ralston the Estimate for Pipe with collars
put together with cement was carried and
adopted all of the Members of the Council voting
for the Estimate

Bill No 23 in regard to water privilege of
J L Cowan, Frank O'Neill and L Foley was read
the first and on motion of C H Ralston was
read the second time by Title and then was
referred to the Committee on Ordinances for
amendment

Bills No 20 & 21 were read by sections
and on motion the amendments were stricken
out and the Bills referred back to the Committee
for amendment as suggested by the Council

Bill No 22 was also recommitted to the
Committee for amendment

The Bills of Jno Elkins for 125⁰⁰ & f.
O'Connor for 13⁰⁰ and W R Blyee for 75⁰⁰ on
Motion of C H Ralston the Rules were sus-
pended and the Bills ordered paid with the
exception of the Bill of E f O'Connor one-half
of which was to be paid by property owners

The Report of the Committee on ap-
and Current expenses recommended the
payment of all Bills and on motion the
Recorder was ordered to draw warrants on the
Treasurer for the same

On Motion C H Ralston, G W Cusack and
G. M. Westfall were appointed as a committee
to make preparations for the Annual supper
to be given the New Council adjourned to
meet Monday Evening Dec 21⁹¹
