Council met pursuant to adjournment, Roll called and Members all present

Committee on Ordinances made their report and amendments on the Bills that were referred to them and on motion of C H Ralston the report was adopted and Bills 20-21-22 and 23 were read the third time and passed the vote standing as follows.

Mr Crusan called the attention of the Council to the fact that the Lamps on Second Street were not lighted and they ordered the deputy Marshal to see that they were cleaned and lighted from now on -

The Committee on Sidewalks and public improvements were asked to notify Mr Courtney to put down the sidewalk in front of his Bricks on Main St -

On Motion of G M Westfall R S Roberts was allowed five (5) dollars more on his Salary

The Bills of P M Smith for 1⁰⁰ M.A. Miller for 10⁶⁵ and Chamness & Sloper Bros for 57⁰⁸ the Rules being suspended, were allowed and warrants on the Treasurer were ordered drawn for the same

The Council then adjourned to meet on Tuesday evening Dec 29th 91
