Council met pursuant to adjournment—
Roll called and Members all present—
except J G Boyer

Minutes of the last regular and
adjourn meeting read and approved—

The Petition of W. A. Miller & R.
Borum and others for a sidewalk to be per
petuation on file was granted

The Bond of Guy Ed Meyer for
Retail Liquor License was read and
approved and the Recorder was ordered
to issue license to them for the term
of six months—

The Bond of J F Swan for Street-
Commissioner was read and approved
ordered to be placed on file and was
duly sworn in office

On Motion the following resolution
was adopted

"Whereas, The draining of the McCally
slough has been about one-half finished, and
whereas it is necessary in order to finish said
Drain, that the sum of \$200⁰⁰ be paid in said
work at this time for labor and material, and
whereas, by resolution at a previous meeting
the said appropriation was only to be paid when
the work had been completed, now therefore, be
it resolved that the sum of \$200⁰⁰ be paid to George
Elkins, to be by him expended for labor and ma-
terial aforesaid and that a warrant be ordered
drawn on the Treasurer for the said \$200⁰⁰—"

The Rules were then suspended and
the following bills were allowed and warrants
ordered drawn on the Treasurer, P C Gordon \$20⁰⁰
