

Lebanon Oregon Nov 15th 1892

Council met at regular Session Roll called and Members all present

Minutes of the last meeting read and approved

On Motion the Water power Franchise was laid over to the next meeting

On Motion duly recorded the resignation of the Marshal took effect—

The applications of S C Mackey and Jos S Warwick for the office of Marshal was read and by Ballot of the Council S C Mackey was elected to fill the Balance of the unexpired term

He was instructed to prepare his Bonds and present them to the Mayor for approval

The Marshal was ordered to notify W. B. Douaca and Masonic Lodge to put in a new sidewalk on the South side of their Bricks building back to the Alley— and also to light the Lamps on the Back streets and keep them burning till 10 o'clock P M of the same day

On motion the following citizens were appointed judges for the City Election to be held on the 5th day of December 1892 P W Morgan, J J Swan and Geo W Crusan for Clerks of said Election. A. A. Kees and C O Backman

The Rules were suspended and the following Bills were allowed and warrants ordered drawn on the Treasurer J C Gordon \$20⁰⁰ and S P Bach \$925-

The Council then adjourned to meet on the 16th of November to do any business that might come before it—
