Lebanon Oregon December 9th 1892

Council met pursuant to adjournment Roll
called and the Members were all present

Minutes of last regular and adjourned
meetings read and approved

The Contract in regard "to lighting the City
by Electric Arc lights," with the Lebanon Electric
Light and water Company was then read and
on motion the following resolution presented
by S P Bach and James S Boyles was adopted
and approved, all of the Council voting for
the Resolution

"Whereas the Contract this day to the City
Council embodying the wishes of the said City of
Lebanon, in regard to furnishing of Electric lights
for said City; be it resolved that the said Contract

be and the same is hereby approved"

signed by S P Bask and Jas G Boyles

Ordinance Bill No 29 was then read the 3^d time and on motion duly seconded the Bill was passed the Members all voting for the same -

On motion the Title of the Bill to be the title of the Ordinance was carried the Council voting for the Motion

The Report of the Canvassers of the City Election held on Dec 5th 1892 for City officers was adopted and ordered to be placed on file and certificates of Election ordered to be issued to successful Candidates

The costs of Printing and recording Ordinance No 26 ("Electric Franchise") was ordered to be refunded to C G Rawlings, which amounted to four dollars and ninety cents"

The fine of Saul M Garland (five dollars) was on motion remitted

The Mayor then appointed Saul M Garland to draw up a Petition to extend the boundaries of the City Corporation and to circulate the same on the outside for signatures and Joseph Elkins to procure names to the petition on the inside of Corporation -

The Bills of C B Montague for and S. R. Claypool for Crosswalk lumber was referred to Committee on Accounts and Current expenses

On motion the Rules were suspended and warrants ordered drawn on The City Treasurer for the following Bills; Buhl & Pugh 35⁰⁰; Saul M Garland 18⁰⁰; P W Morgan 2⁰⁰; R. C. Miller 2⁰⁰; J. J. Swan 2⁰⁰; C C Hackleman 2⁰⁰; O W Stokes 2⁰⁰; U. A. Miller 2²⁵ and S C Mackey 43⁰⁰ C G Rawlings 4⁹⁰ and Saul M Garland's fine of 5⁰⁰
