

Council Chamber. August 1893.

Council met pursuant to adjournment  
Roll call - Present - The Mayor and all members  
all the Bills present at last meeting were re-  
ported upon favorably by Com. on Accounts and  
Current expenses and were allowed and  
warrants ordered drawn - save the bill  
of R. Troy which was allowed to the  
amount of \$6<sup>35</sup>.

Bond of Guy & Mayor for Leg. License was  
read and approved - and license ordered  
issued in pursuance thereof, for six  
months from Aug 22 1893, the sum of \$300 -  
having been paid by them to City Treasurer, a  
duplicate receipt for the amount being filed  
with their Bond.

The City Atty was instructed to communicate  
with the S. P. R. R. officers relative to the con-  
struction of cross-walks over their right of  
way.

Marshal was instructed to ascertain the  
reasons, if any, why the parties hereto  
had notified him not to award their  
side walks as per notice.

Resignation of J. C. Belgrave, as member of the  
Council, was read and laid on table.  
Bill of D. Courtney and of J. S. Roberts for at-  
tendance upon Dr. Martin read and  
referred to Committee on Accounts and  
current Expenses.

Council adjourned to next Regular meeting.
