Sept. 19th 1893

Council met in regular session
Roll call, All members present
except Councilman Westfall

Minutes of last meeting
read and approved

On motion the
Council proceeded to unfinished
business.

On motion the resignation
of G. M. Westfall as Councilman was
taken from the table and the same
accepted. Ed. Kellenbuer was
placed in nomination to fill the
expired term of Councilman Westfall

No other nominations being made
the same was ordered closed and the
roll being called Ed Kellenbuer was
unanimously elected and so declared

The oath of office was duly
administered by the Recorder

On motion the resignation
of J. C. Pilyer was taken from the
table and duly accepted

N. S. Darglish was placed in
nomination to fill the expired term
of J. C. Pilyer as Councilman

There being no other nomination
the roll was ordered called which
resulted in his being declared unanimously
elected. The oath of office was
then administered by the Recorder

The new Councilman were
appointed on committees to fill
the places of those resigning

The City Atty made verbal
report as to Quincy. R. Kuhler

Manager of the S. R. R.R. as to building walks across the railroad he also submitted letter which was placed on file, The same was referred to the Street Committee

Marshal made verbal report as to satisfying all parties required to build and repair side walks

An motion J. B. Thompson was ordered to remove his barn back of the St. Charles Hotel from the Street and alley An motion the Electric Light and Water Co was ordered to fix the streets in as good condition as when entered upon
