Lebanon Oregon Oct. 17<sup>th</sup> 1893

Council met in regular session

Roll call, all members present except Councilman Halglirk, Minutes of last regular and special meetings read and approved

Committee on streets made verbal reports as to cross walks across the Railroad track, the city atty was by unanimous consent authorized to correspond with the Railroad Co as to the proper place for sidewalks across the railroad and see what further preparation should be satisfactory

Petitions of J. M. Stokes and others also O'Neil & Co & others for Electric Light ~~and~~ ~~and~~ road.

On motion the same was referred to the Street Committee, also petition for cross walk opposite or near J. Massons residence across Main Street was presented & read. On motion the same was referred to the Street Committee

On motion the Recorder was instructed to notify the Electric Light and Water Co to put in a light at the intersection of Grant and Grove Street at or near the Baptist Church, the same to be under the supervision of the Street Committee.
