Oct. 31st 1893

Council met according to previous adjournment. Roll Call, All members present except Councilman Dalglis.

Band of J. P. Murray, with application for Retail Liquor License with receipt of the license for \$300 for six months license was presented and read.

On motion the band was approved and the Recorder was instructed to issue license to applicant for the period named. On motion six trees in front of the property of Kirkpatrick on Main Street was ordered cut down close to the ground and removed from the street. Also on motion six trees in front of on near residence of J. A. Penell was ordered cut down and removed if found in the street, on Main Street. On motion the Electric Light at the intersection of Rose and Main Street was ordered to be removed to Vine and Main Street the same to be erected on a 60 foot pole. On motion the Electric Light at intersection of Grant and Main Street was ordered to be raised. The following Bills were presented & read. To wit

Electric Light Co for water for month of Oct \$40⁰⁰ also for lights \$60⁰⁰. P. W. Morgan for 1 month salary \$20⁰⁰. W. C. Peterson for 1st whitening for repairs on Hoop. \$1.50 On motion the rules were suspended and the bills ordered paid except W. C. Peterson which was referred to Finance Committee.
