Council met in regular session

Roll call, All members present except Councilman Dalglisk. Communication from Sudouille in reference to purchasing the old street lamps was read. On motion the Recorder was instructed to answer same by stating they were reasonably worth \$9.⁰⁰ apiece and that the City should dispose of them at that price. On motion

Councilman Carson presented Ordinance bill No 32 to amend Sec. 7th of Ordinance No 16 relating to the election of Town Officers increasing the number of Councilmen to six, which was read the first time.

By motion the Council by unanimous vote of all present ordered the bill to be read a second time by title. The bill being neither committed or amended, the Recorder was ordered to call the roll to see whether it should be passed to the 3rd reading which resulted as follows.

Miller for stationery & \$ 1.05 was presented & read, and on motion the rules were suspended and a warrant order drawn on the Treasurer for the same. No further business on motion the Council adjourned.
