

Council Chambers Lebanon Or Nov 20th
1894

Present the Hon C B Montague Mayor
and Councilmen Rice, Cotton, Andrews,
Kellenburger and Myers Absent, Reed.

The committee on accounts and current
expenditures reported favorably on the
two bills of Westfall & Smith and
upon motion the report was adopted
ordered placed on file & warrants ordered
drawn on the Treasurer for the amounts

A communication from C. G. Rawlings
was read after which it was moved
and carried that the same be placed on
file and that the action of the Council
in relation to the Bonding of the City
for the purpose of purchasing the
Lebanon Electric Light & Water
plant & bringing the question before
the people of the City at the next
election be annulled.

Upon motion the rules were suspen-
ded and the following Bills against
the City were allowed and warrants
ordered drawn therefor

It was then moved and carried that
the Committee on health and Police
be instructed to see the Merchants
& ascertain the amount they would
contribute toward the employment of
a night Watch, to inform them that

The city would through its Council
 pay their share of said expense
 and that said committee be authorized
 to act at once and to forthwith erect
 street lamps in the principal alleys
 & streets of the city in such places as to
 them seemed best

The Council then adjourned in due
 form to meet at the next regular
 meeting December 14th 1894
