Present the Hon O.B. Montague Mayor
and Councilmen Rice, Cotton Myers
Andrews and Kelleher. Absent Coun-
cilman Reed

The minutes of the last meeting were
read and approved

The Committee on Health & Police to
whom was referred the matter
of the appointment of a night Watch-
man & the erection of street lamps
in certain dark alleys & streets
reported as follows. "After investiga-
tion we find that no satisfactory
arrangements can be made and would
recommend that the matter be
dropped for the present."

The Recorder read a communication
from J.W. Howell relative to the pur-
chase of two of the city's old street
lamps and upon motion the Marshall
was instructed to ship the same at
once and by the same motion a sum
sufficient to pay the freight chgs
to Salem was appropriated out of
the General fund

The Report of the Hon O B Montague
Mayor and Att Stowe Recorder
constituting the Canvassing Board
of the late city election was read
and upon motion was accepted &
ordered placed on file
