Council Chamber, Lebanon, Oregon,
September 3, 1895

Present M. A. Miller, Mayor and Councilmen
Dalglish, Myers, Rice, Bilyeu and Kellenberger.
Absent Councilman Long.

Minutes of the previous meeting were
read and approved.

The Committee on Ordinances reported an
Ordinance relating to Cattle and prohibiting
their running at large within the City limits.

The Ordinance was then read the first time.

Upon motion the rules were suspended
and the Ordinance read the second time
by title only. Those voting yes were Rice
Myers, Kellenberger and Dalglish. Those voting
No. Bilyeu, - Absent Long.

The Ordinance was then read the second
time by title only.

Motion made that the Ordinance be referred
to the Committee on Ordinances for amend-
ments. The roll being called the vote
stood Bilyeu No, Rice No, Myers Yes,
Dalglish Yes, Kellenberger Yes. Long Absent.
So the Ordinance was referred to the
Committee on Ordinances for
amendments.

The City Recorder then reported that he had corresponded with Mr. N. H. Allen in regard to the water-tank being empty at times and that Mr. Allen had agreed to have the tank kept full in the future.

A Communication from County Judge J. N. Duncan was then read to the Council relating to the taxes of 1893.

Upon motion the Communication was placed on file.

A reply to Judge Duncan's communication was then introduced in the form of a resolution by Councilman Rice.

The Communication was then read to the Council.

Moved and carried that the Communication just read be sent to Judge Duncan as a reply to his communication relating to taxes.

A communication was then read, from W. C. Ayleworth requesting the Council to refund his license of six dollars.

Moved and carried that the communication of W. C. Ayleworth be placed on file.

Moved and carried that the license be refunded to W. C. Ayleworth.

Councilman Bilyeu asked if there was an ordinance licensing Auctioneers.

The Recorder answered that there was a license of \$5.00 per quarter for Auctioneers.

Councilman Rice then asked why the City jail held a man without process of law. The prisoner was ordered released.

Moved and carried that all outstanding Warrants of Arrest be canceled and the City officers instructed not to prosecute said parties for said offences.

There was then presented to the Council twenty-six bills against the City - Eight on the general fund and eighteen on

the Road and Street fund for street work and material.

Moved and carried that the eight bills on the general fund be allowed and the rules suspended and warrants ordered drawn on the treasurer for the several amounts.
