

## Council Chamber, Lebanon, Or.

November 5, 1895.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

A report of the street work for 1895 from the City Marshal was then read to the Council.

Moved and carried that the clerk and judges for the next annual election be elected to night and that the Recorder give proper notice of the election <sup>and that the Marshal procure a suitable place and necessary furniture for holding</sup> C. W. Stokes, S. O. Wallace and C. B. Montague were nominated for judge and W. C. Peterson and A. Gotsche were nominated for clerks of the coming election.

Moved and carried that nominations be closed and that the Recorder be instructed to cast the ballot of the Council for the five persons just nominated. The said parties were duly elected.
