Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The Committee on Streets and Public Property reported in writing that they believed that a sidewalk should be built on the north side of Lot #7, in Block #3 in Kirkpatrick's Addition between Park and Grove Streets.

Moved and carried that the report be accepted and placed on file and that the walk be ordered built, and for the Marshal to see that this order is complied with. Councilman Dalgleish of the Committee on Streets and Public Property reported that he was in favor of buying

the Electric Light and water plant if the same could be purchased for a reasonable sum.

This report was followed by a general discussion of the matter but no action was taken regarding the same.

A. B. Nickerson Chief of the Fire Department appeared before the Council and asked that a duplicate of Warrant #214, for the sum of Forty-four and ⁷⁵/₁₀₀ Dollars drawn in favor of Lebanon Engine Co #7. be issued as they had lost the original warrant.

Moved and carried that the request of Mr. Nickerson be granted and a duplicate warrant issued.

Moved and carried that the rules be suspended and that the following bills be allowed and warrants be ordered drawn on the Treasurer for the several amounts.
