The minutes were then read and approved
 without objection.

After the reading of the minutes the
 doctors present each made short addresses
 in which they set forth their ideas
 regarding the nature of diphtheria and
 the necessary amount of precaution
 required to stamp out the disease.

In order that the doctors might
 more thoroughly understand the City
 laws governing contagious diseases
 the Recorder read parts of the Health
 Ordinance.

The doctors present expressed themselves
 to the effect that the law was strict
 enough to wipe out the disease,
 if properly enforced.

The doctors present agreed to hereafter
 superintend all fumigations of all

places where they had treated patients.
 Moved and carried that Dr. Foley be requested to do the same.

Moved and carried that the physicians when called to see a patient and ascertain that he or she is suffering from diphtheria that they take the names of all persons who are present who refuse or fail to fumigate themselves according to his directions before leaving the house, and report the same to the City Marshal in writing.

Moved and carried that a vote of thanks be tendered to the Physicians in attendance for the information furnished and for courtesies shown the City Council.
