Mr Garland informed the Council that Kellnerberger had instructed W.C. Peterson draft a map of the proposed road and send below for record

Mr G B Hansard & Chas Blodgett came before the Council in regard to closing alley and they were instructed not to close the same -

The Marshal was instructed to notify all parties having cows that after ten days notice the Ordinance would be enforced

The Electric Light & Water Bills of 50⁰⁰ & 42⁵⁰ Marshal of 21⁵⁰ Rice 10⁹⁵ Garland 6⁰⁰ were read and on motion duly carried

the Rules were suspended the Bills allowed and the Recorder instructed to issue warrants on the City Treasurer for the same

Mr Haugs was present and spoke of the Light-Contract expiring Jan 1st 98 and requested the Council to take the matter under consideration

The Mayor appointed Boles Umphrey and Peterson as a Special Committee to act in the matter and report next meeting

The Marshall presented his resignation as Night-watch and on motion duly carried it was accepted
