The Council met in regular session Roll was called and Councilman Long was absent

Minutes of the last meeting read and approved

The Standing and Special Committees asked for further time to report which was granted

The Committee Spaulding on Hickman Hydrant was instructed to fetch in a written report and either recommend or reject the same

Mr Ausorge came before the Council and complained of the water from the Ditch flooding his property and was referred to Ed O'Neil

Mr Hughs was present and spoke of the Light-Contract-expiring Jan 1<sup>st</sup> 98 and requested the Council to take the matter under consideration

The Mayor appointed Boies Humphrey and Peterson as a Special Committee to act in the matter and report next meeting

The Marshall presented his resignation as Night-watch and on motion duly carried it was accepted

The Bill of John Carroll as Night-watch for 3<sup>00</sup> was read and for motion the Rules were suspended the Bill allowed & warrant ordered drawn on the City Treasurer for same - Council then adjourned
