

Council Chamber, Lebanon Ore

October 5, 1897

Present Mayor L. Foley and Councilmen  
Boyle, Beaman Morris and Peterson.

Absent Councilman Amphrey and Long.  
Minutes of the previous meeting were read  
and approved as read.

By unanimous consent of the Council they  
passed from the regular order of business  
and took up the subject of Contract for  
Electric Lights. The City Attorney then presented  
to the Council a form of contract which was  
discussed at length and which was  
finally decided upon as being satisfactory to  
all concerned.

The Council then returned to the regular order  
of business and a special Committee on the  
matter of the Kellenberger Road was granted  
further time in which to make their report.  
City Treasurer J. F. Hyde then appeared before the Council  
and read his 3rd quarterly report for the year  
ending December 31st 1897 and upon motion  
the same was accepted and ordered placed  
on file.

A petition from J. C. Mayer and others was  
then read to the Council asking that bicyclists  
be granted the privilege of riding upon all  
sidewalks of the City save on Main Street  
from Ash street to Maple street and on  
Sherman street from St Charles Hotel to Depot.

No action being taken the Council passed to the  
next order of business.

Moved and carried that the action of the Recorder  
in issuing a bowling Alley license to Weston  
P Hughes for one quarter for the sum of \$<sup>3</sup>-<sup>00</sup>  
and also for issuing a pool table license  
to G. M. Smith for one quarter for the sum  
of \$<sup>2</sup>-<sup>50</sup> be approved by the Council.

Upon motion the rules were suspended the following bills were allowed and warrants ordered drawn on the Treasurer for the several amounts.
