

Council Chamber, Lebanon, Oregon,  
Nov. 2, 1897.

Present Mayor L. Foley and Councilmen,

The City Atty reported that in the matter of the  
Kellenberger road, he had sent description of the  
land to the Company in Portland but had not yet  
received the required deed.

The Recorder was instructed to notify Mr. Hughes,  
of the fact that the Council had ordered a new hydrant  
placed at the cross street near Phil Kitter's re-  
sidence.

J. H. P. Hoke then appeared before the Council and  
asked that they grant him a skating rink license  
for \$5.00 for the term of one quarter. The Recorder also  
stated that Merton Hughes desired a shooting  
gallery license at reduced rates for two months.

Moved and carried that the Recorder issue Mr. Hoke  
a skating rink license for one quarter for \$5.00  
and that he issue a shooting gallery license  
to Mr. Hughes at the rate of \$6.00 per quarter,  
with the understanding that shooting gallery and  
bowling alley be not run at the same time with-  
out a dividing wall between them.

Moved and carried that all business transacted at  
the last regular meeting be ratified.

The Com. on Streets and Public Property was  
instructed to look up the matter of putting  
in a new cross walk at street near Mr. Clapp's  
place.

R. C. Miller, J. R. Smith and S. A. Nickerson  
were nominated for judges of election and  
A. Gotschee and W. C. Peterson were nominated  
for clerks of election to act at the City election  
to be held the 1st Monday in December.

Moved and carried that the persons nominated  
be elected to fill the places of judges & clerks respectively.
