Council met in regular session.

Minutes of the previous meeting  
were read and approved.

Moved and carried that the road  
and street committee, through  
the Marshal, serve notice on all  
parties who have been notified, to  
repair or rebuild their walks within  
ten days or that the City Council  
will take the necessary legal  
steps to enforce the same.

Moved and carried that the  
Recorder be instructed to notify  
Mr. S. W. Cruson that the City  
does not care to longer carry  
insurance on the City hall.

Moved and carried that the rules  
be suspended the following bills  
be allowed and warrants be  
ordered drawn on the treasurer  
for the several amounts

Council Chamber, Lebanon, Oregon.  
October 4, 1875.

Present Mayor N. W. Smith and Councilmen Morris, Baker, Knowles and Aldrich, Absent Councilmen Menzies and Chadler. Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

W. C. Peterson Chief of the Fire Department and urged the Council to take action to improve the fire service of the City. Treas. J. F. Hyde then read to the Council his third quarterly report which shows the indebtedness of the City to be \$2740<sup>00</sup> exclusive of accrued interest.

Motion carried that the report be accepted and placed on file.

Dr. J. A. Lamberson then appeared before the Council and made some appropriate remarks regarding the indebtedness of the City also regarding the health of the City and sanitary measures.

Messrs. Etkin, Burtenshaw, Peterson and Rice appeared before the Council in a few remarks each regarding the draining of the slough in the north part of the City.

Motion carried that the matter of draining the slough be left as theretofore decided by the Council at a former meeting.
