Council Chamber, Lebanon, Oregon.
October 4, 1875.

Present Mayor N. W. Smith and Councilmen Morris, Baker, Knowles and Aldrich, Absent Councilmen Menzies and Chadler. Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

W. C. Peterson Chief of the Fire Department and urged the Council to take action to improve the fire service of the City. Treas. J. F. Hyde then read to the Council his third quarterly report which shows the indebtedness of the City to be \$2740⁰⁰ exclusive of accrued interest.

Motion carried that the report be accepted and placed on file.

Dr. J. A. Lamberson then appeared before the Council and made some appropriate remarks regarding the indebtedness of the City also regarding the health of the City and sanitary measures.

Messrs. Etkin, Burtenshaw, Peterson and Rice appeared before the Council in a few remarks each regarding the draining of the slough in the north part of the City.

Motion carried that the matter of draining the slough be left as theretofore decided by the Council at a former meeting.

Motion and carried that the Marshal notify all parties having privies or wath closets on their premises to clean up the same or move them by making another vault.

Motion and carried that the action of the Council be published also the fact that the Committee on health would inspect all cleaning up done and prosecute all parties who failed to clean up their premises as notified.

Marshal John Carroll stated to the Council that he would be absent from the City for ten days and asked that a leave of absence be granted for that time.

Motion and carried that the Marshal be granted a leave of absence as requested.

Dr. J. H. P. Hope then appeared before the Council and asked that he be granted an opera house and skating rink license one year for Ten Dollars.

Motion and carried that the license be granted to Dr Hope as requested.

Motion and carried that the rules be suspended the following bills be allowed and warrants be ordered drawn on the treasurer for the several amounts.
