Council Chamber, Lebanon, Ore.
Oct. 11, 1898.

Council met pursuant to a call of
the Mayor, present Mayor, N. W. Smith
and Councilmen Baker, Knowles,
Aldrich and Menzies, absent Council-
men Morris and Chaddle.

Minutes of the previous meeting were
read and approved.

The Mayor then stated that the object
for which the meeting had been called,
was to take action to prevent the
diphtheria from breaking out in the city.

The matter of preventing an epidemic
of diphtheria and the proper way
of handling the matter was discussed
at considerable length, Drs. Lamberson
and Booth were present and gave
their opinion regarding what could
be done, advising the Council to
enforce strictly all quarantine laws
of the city and to prevent if possi-
ble the coming to town of persons from
families or places having the disease.

Moved and carried that the health
ordinances of the city be strictly
enforced by the Marshal and that
all persons coming to town from places
infected with diphtheria be prosecuted
according to the laws of the city.
