Council met pursuant to adjourn-
ment, and was called to order by

James Burtenshaw stated to the Council
that there was some defective sidewalk
on north Main street. The matter
of ordering repairs to sidewalk was
left to Road & Street Committee.

Marshall Carroll stated that the
parties living near the old Exchange
Hotel desired a crosswalk across
Main street at the old hotel.

Moved and carried that the Council
now proceed to the election of three
judges and two clerks to serve
at the coming city election.

Nominations for judges were declared in
order - Dew H. Harshbarger, M. Stokes & Frank Thompson.

Motion and carried that the nominations be closed and that the three nominated be declared duly elected.

Nominations for Clerks was then declared to be in order and Frank Miller, W.C. Peterson and W.E. Harden were placed in nomination.

Ballot was taken which resulted as follows; Frank Miller III, W.C. Peterson III and W.E. Harden II.

Frank Miller and W.C. Peterson were declared duly elected.

Motion and carried that the City Election be held in the Engine room.

Motion and carried that the rules be suspended and the following bills be allowed.
