

Council Chamber, Lebanon,

November, 15, 1898.

Council met in regular session with Mayor Smith in the chair.

Present Councilmen: Baker, Morris, Aldrich and Knowles.  
Absent Councilman: Menzies and Cheadle.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Council discussed the advisability of having charter amended so as to permit of an increased tax levy. It was decided that the matter should be left to the next Council.

Two bills were read to the Council one of Wm Retherford for hauling eight loads of gravel to amount of \$4<sup>00</sup> and one of J. A. Nickerson for lumber to amount of \$10<sup>11</sup>/<sub>100</sub>.  
Morrow and carried that the rules be suspended and the bill of Wm Retherford for \$4<sup>00</sup> be allowed and a warrant ordered drawn on the treasurer for the amount.
