Lebanon Or, Aug 1st 1899

Council called to order by Mayor
C. B. Montague

At the request of the Mayor the
recorder called the roll which showed all
Councilmen and officers present except
Councilman B. Burtinshaw and Attorney
S. M. Garland and City Treasurer Geo. W. Rice

Minutes of July 8th 1899 Read and approved
also Minutes of Adjourned Meeting of July 18
read and approved.

ON Motion Mrs Kate Sysler
being present asked the Council to grant
her one year time to build new side
walk in front of her Lots on Vine street.

ON Motion of Councilman F. A.
Nickerson Mrs Sysler was granted
ONE year time in which to build new
side walk in front of her Lots on Vine street.

ON Motion the street Commissioner
was instructed to have the street in front of the
property where W. Retherford lives repaired
at once also street repaired near the
residence of G. H. Bland.

ON motion the City marshal
was instructed to notify property owners
where sidewalks were in bad condition to
repair the same within 5 days from service
of Notice to repair the same.

The marshal was also instructed to
have the Cross walk on second street at the
intersection of Sherman street repaired.

ON Motion the Recorder was
instructed to have 300 Sidewalk Notices
printed at lowest cost possible to the City.

ON Motion the Recorder together
with the Mayor was instructed to Re R.

Kohler Manager of S. P. Ry. Co. to prepare an Ordinance for the dedication of the right-of-way across their Rail Road Grounds on the line of Grant Street. The said Rail Road Ground asked to be dedicated having been used as a public street and street crossing for over Fifteen years.

on motion Recorder was instructed to Notify

To repair or Tear down the old Building situate on Block 1. Lot 1 in A. Cowans Addition to Lebanon Co. as the same is in a dangerous condition to life.

ON Motion the Recorder was instructed to issue street License to one Thomas Styner at the rate of \$25⁰⁰ per day with a rebate of \$22⁰⁰ on each License issued.

Complaints having been made to Members of the City Council that one Jefferson had been putting out Poisons which had delt out death to Canines and many different breeds of Cats.

ON motion the City Marshal was instructed to notify Mr Jefferson not to persist further in Putting out Poison within the City Limits.

Mayor Montague presented the proposition of the Manager of the L. E. L. & W. Co. for the City to purchase one half interest in the Plant.

ON Motion the Mayor was requested to site up the proposition in detail and publish the same for the consideration of the Citizens of City.

ON Motion Tax Collector Geo. W. Rice was granted 30 days

further time to complete collection of taxes,
and that he notify all delinquent persons
of the same.
