Council Called to order by the Mayor C. B. Montague

Mr. E. Karden Chairman of the Special Committee as to the proposed purchase of  $\frac{1}{2}$  the L. E. L. & M. Co Plant made report in way of presenting Petition which had been prepared by the Committee and circulated and signed by the Legal Voters of the City.

On motion the Petition was ordered filed and Committee honorably discharged.

On motion the Committee to look as to the advisability of draining of the slough in the North end of the City were given further time to report and were instructed to invite O'Neil Bros and Calaghan to meet with the said Committee at the call of the Chairman of the Committee

Treasurer Rice made verbal report as to the amount of Taxes Collected and amount remaining uncollected.

On motion all unpaid taxes due the City this 5<sup>th</sup> day of Sept. 1899 are declared delinquent, and the Treasurer authorized to notify delinquent persons that additional cost will be added on and after Nov. 1<sup>st</sup> 1899

 his resignation as Councilman owing  
 to his moving to August
