Lebanon Oregon Oct. 10th 1899

Cannels called to Order by Recorder Peterson,

In absence of the Mayor W.E. Harder was duly nominated and elected Mayor Protem for the evening.

Roll call showed the following Councilmembers present

B. Burtenshaw, E. Cather, D.W. Harder
W.E. Harder and F. A. Nickerson.

The following officers were also present Treasurer Geo. W. Rice,

City Marshal P. Ritter and Recorder W.C. Peterson,

Minutes of the meetings of Sept. 5th and Oct. 3rd were read and approved.

Third Quarterly report of Treasurer Geo. W. Rice, was read, and on motion accepted and ordered placed on file.

Recorder asked for further time to prepare his Report, on motion the Recorder was granted further time to prepare his Report.

The Petition of E. Cather and others asking the privilege to build a Bridge at their own cost and expense across the Tail Race of the Lebanon and Sention Canal on Keatt street, was taken from the table,

and on motion E. Cather & others were granted the privilege of constructing a Bridge as asked for in said Petition,

in the absence of the Chairman of the committee to look into the advisability of draining the Slough in the North end of the City. A motion was duly made and carried that the Mayor appoint a special committee to investigate

the advisability of draining the slough in the north end of the city and report at the next regular meeting, Mayor appointed Councilmen, D. W. Hardin, F. A. Nickerson & B. Burtushaw,

On motion the Council proceeded to the election of a Councilman to fill the vacancy caused by the resignation of Councilman C. O. Peterson

The Ballot being duly taken showed the following result: J. C. Pitzer received one vote and Grant Lindley three votes Grant Lindley having received the majority vote was declared duly elected Councilman by the Mayor, to fill the ~~vacancy~~ remainder of the term caused by the resignation of Councilman C. O. Peterson,

The Bill of C. Harrett for \$2.00 for hauling gravel in front of the property of E. Kellinberger, ^{2 loads} W. Sealand, one load, and Mrs S. C. Wallace 2 loads, was read and on motion warrant ordered drawn to pay same and the recorder instructed to make out Bills and present them for payment to the above named property owners,
