

# Council Chamber

Lebanon Or. Oct. 17<sup>th</sup> 1899

Council called to order by Recorder Peterson in absence of the Mayor D. W. Hardin was nominated and elected Mayor pro tem for the evening.

On the calling of the Roll the following Councilmen and officers were present B. Burtenshaw, E. Cather, D. W. Hardin, W. E. Harden, and F. A. Pickerson. Councilman, Geo. W. Rice City Treasurer, Philip Ritter City Marshal and W. C. Peterson City Recorder, Mayor C. B. Montague City Attorney S. M. Garland being absent. Minutes of Previous Meeting read and approved.

City Marshal Ritter reported that he had notified the Property owners ~~of~~ on the East Side of Main Street between Isabella and Wheeler Street to Repair or Build new side walk, and that the time for the Property owners to repair or build new walk in accordance to notice had expired and the necessary repairs and new walks had not been done.

The matter as to repairs or building new side walks was left in the hands of the City Marshal with instructions to enforce in accordance to Ordinance governing same.

Ordinance Committee asked till next regular meeting to interduce New Opera House Ordinance, Committee was given the time asked for.

On motion the old building situated on 2<sup>nd</sup> Block in a corner addition was declared a nuisance, and the City Marshal instructed to tear down the same at once as the Building in it present condition is

dangerous to life,

The special committee appointed to investigate the advisability of draining the slough in the north end of the city reported that they had investigated the same and asked till next regular meeting to make full report as they had not as yet gotten prices on sewerage tile, Committee was granted the time asked for,

ON Motion Council adjourned.
