

Council Chamber

Lebanon Or, Nov. 14th 1899

Council called to order by City Recorder Peterson in absence of the Mayor, W. C. Hardin was nominated and Elected Protem Mayor for the evening by the Councilmen present

Roll call showed all Councilmen and officers present except Mayor C. B. Montage, and City attorney Am. Garland & Treasurer G. O. Rice, Minutes of previous meeting read and approved.

Councilman F. A. Nickerson presented and read subscription list as to the amount subscribed for the draining of the slough in the North end of the city

ON motion the subscription list was accepted by the Council and the Committee discharged

J. B. Hope made application for skating rink license offering to pay \$5⁰⁰ for one Quarters license

ON motion J. B. Hope was rebated \$2⁰⁰ from the usual or ordinance price and the Recorder instructed to issue J. B. Hope skating rink license for one Quarter for Five Dollars,

ON motion the Committee on streets and public Property were empowered and instructed to proceed at once to have the slough in the North End of the City drained the expense to the City not to exceed One Hundred and fifty Dollars, and the subscription list was ordered turned over to said Committee or additional revenue to be applied on expense of said drain.

Letter and agreement from R. Kohler manager of the O. P. R. R. Co.

Read and on motion the mayor and Recorder were instructed to sign the agreement as to laying of a temporary walk across the R. R. grounds on Grant Street and return one copy to Mr. Köhler and file the other in the office of the City Recorder.
