

Council Chamber

Lebanon O. Nov. 21st 1879

Council Called to Order by City Recorder Peterson in absence of the Mayor.

D. W. Hardin was nominated and elected Mayor Protem for the evening.

Calling the Roll of Officers, showed all Councilmen and officers present except Mayor C. B. Montague and City Atty S. M. Garland and City Treasurer Geo. W. Rice.

Minutes of previous meeting read and approved.

Committee on streets and Public property reported that the Committee had seen Mr. O'Neill and were arranging for the purchase of the sewage pipe for the slough in the north end of the city.

On motion the Council proceeded to the election of Councilman to fill the vacancy caused by the resignation of C. C. Peterson. As the newly elected Councilman Grant Lindley had not presented himself in the time prescribed by law and taken the oath of office the same was declared vacant and a new election declared.

The vote being taken Grant Lindley ~~was~~ received a majority vote of the members of the Council present and declared by the Mayor duly elected to fill the vacancy caused by the resignation of Councilman C. C. Peterson.

Grant Lindley presented himself to the desk of the City Recorder and signed the oath of office and was duly sworn in to his respective office as Councilman to fill the

unexpired term of C. O. Peterson

On motion the City Marshal as well as the Committee on Health & Police to enforce the ordinance governing the spreading of contagious diseases,

on motion the following Bill was read and allowed.
