

## Council Chamber

Lebanon, W. Dec 5<sup>th</sup> 1899

Council called to order by Mayor C. B. Montague

on the calling of the roll, showed all councilmen and officers present except City Attorney S. M. Garland and Treasurer Geo. W. Rice

Minutes of previous meeting read and approved

Treasurer Geo. W. Rice entered the Council Chamber and took his seat as Treasurer

On motion the street commissioner was ordered to put a crosswalk ~~at~~ in at the south west corner of J. R. Smith's Property on Bridge Avenue.

On motion the Recorder was instructed to notify Dr. J. P. Wallall and J. M. Settle to build sidewalk on south side of Grant street along the north end of their lots on same.

On motion the Recorder was instructed to notify all Property owners on the south side of Bridge Avenue who had not already built sidewalk to build new walks at once, the same to begin at the intersection of Grove and Bridge Avenue streets East to the North West corner of a Hall's property.

Committee on Streets and public property made report of their work which was read to the Council and ordered placed on file.

On motion a warrant for \$82.10 was ordered drawn in favor of the Committee on Streets and public property to pay freight and Balance on file, and discount on City warrant.

On motion the draining of the slough in the North End of the City was postponed till more favorable weather to do the work.

Treasurer Rice made verbal report as to the amount on hand in City Treasurer

Recorder Peterson presented his 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarterly Report, as to the amounts drawn on the General fund and Road and Street fund, and also as to the amounts received on dog tax, licenses and fines, and the disbursements of the same.

On motion the Reports of the Recorder was referred to the Committee on Accounts & Current Expenses.

Petition of A. J. Boyd & other for a cross walk on main street from the South West corner of J. W. Menzies Property to the South East corner of S. H. Mayer's Property was presented and read to the Council, and on motion granted and the Street Commissioner ordered to build new cross walk as asked for by the Petitioners.

The L. E. L. & M. Co asked the privilege to move the arc light on Bridge Avenue to the opposite side of the street.

On motion the L. E. L. & M. Co, was granted the privilege to move the arc light at their own cost and expense, the same to be moved to place on said street that the Committee on Streets and Public Property might designate, and be agreed upon by the parties herein named.
