Lebanon Or. Sept. 22<sup>nd</sup> 1900

Council Called to Order by Mayor M. A. Miller Roll call showed the following

A. M. Ayers asked the privilege of moving his sidewalk from the south side of Block One Kirkpatrick addition to South Side on Isabella Street. On motion A. M. Ayers

was granted leave to move sidewalk as asked for.

On motion of W. E. Chandler, O'Neil Ross and Peterson were notified to remove the wreckage of the Excelsior Mill.

On motion the committee on Ordinance were instructed to have prepared by the City Attorney, an Ordinance restricting work done by heavy Tracing Engines.

On motion Maud Kirkpatrick and Mrs. J. C. Ralston were ordered to build new sidewalk abutting their premises on South Side of Maple Street between Park and Main Streets.

J. B. Reed presented petition from J. R. Smith and others, asking the City Council not to require John Nichols and John Reed Treasurer of City Treasurers <sup>Reed</sup> to make good the loss the City sustained by reason of the failure of the Lebanon Banking Company, in which the funds of the City were placed.
