Lebanon Or. Oct 5th 1900

Council Called to Order by Mayor M. A. Miller
Roll call showed all Councilmen present
Except Councilman Asa Baker

Marshal and Recorder were present the
Balance of the officers being absent,
Minutes of the previous meetings of Sept 20th
and Oct 2nd Read and approved

J. M. Burtenshaw being present Made a
Statement as to the proposition of draining the Slough
in the North End of the City, after considerable
talk as to the feasibility of the draining the matter
was left in the hands of the Street Committee

X Mayor C. B. Montague being present presented
the matter of the Cities Money being tied up in the
late Bank failures and asked the City Council
to approve the Petition of John R. Smith and
Others

The Petition was ~~not~~ disallowed and
the City Attorney instructed to proceed to collect
Bond of City Treasurer

On motion of Ed. Kellenger and
seconded by W. C. Chandler, the following Resolution
was adopted

Whereas,

Asa Baker, a duly elected & qualified
Member of the City Council of the City of Lebanon,
Lin County, Oregon, has ceased to be a resident of
said City and is now and for thirty days last past
has been a resident of Laconia, in said County,

Now, therefore, be it and it is hereby resolved
that the office of Councilman held by said
Asa Baker is vacant and the said Asa
Baker is no longer a Councilman of said
City dated this 5th day of October 1900.

On motion nomination were declared in
order for Councilman to fill the vacancy

term of Asa Baker,

H. Y. Kirkpatrick was nominated for Councilman, there being no further nominations nomination were declared closed by the Mayor Mayor ordered Roll call on the vote for H. Y. Kirkpatrick which resulted as follows,

H. Y. Kirkpatrick received the unanimous vote of the Council, and was declared elected to fill the unexpired term of Asa Baker.

Kirkpatrick in to the Council Chamber, the same being done and the Certificate of Election being prepared was read on him by the Recorder, and the oath of Office taken, H. Y. Kirkpatrick took his seat as a member of the Council. On motion the following Bill was allowed and warrants ordered drawn on Treasurer to pay same
