Lebanon W. Oct 16 - 1900

Council Called to Order by Mayor M. A. Miller

Roll Call showed all Councilmen present Also Recorder Marshall City Attorney Garland reported through the Mayor, that he had collected from the Bondsmen of City Treasurer, the full amount of deficiency of the City Treasurer caused by the Late Bank failure.

On Motion the City Attorney S. M. Garland was instructed to turn the Money over to the City, and that the Treasurer be instructed to pay same out on outstanding warrants.

Prof. Jas. B. Boyle being present made a statement as to his riding on sidewalk with a bicycle, and asked the City Council to have the case dismissed against him. B. Burtinshaw and Ed. Killinger voted against the case being dismissed and the Balance of the Council voting for the dismissing of the case, the City Recorder was thereby instructed to dismiss the case.

On Motion the Building of New sidewalk by Mrs. Maud Kirkpatrick and Mrs. J. C. Ralston was ordered indefinitely postponed.

On Motion the City Treasurer was ordered to be present, at next regular meeting and make Report as to the amount of Taxes collected and the amount of delinquents ^{tax} not collected, for 1899 & 1900.
