Council Called to order by Mayor M. A. Miller
 Roll call showed all Councilmen present
 except W. E. Chandler, City Recorder and
 City Marshal were also present.

Petition of L. Foley together with Indemnify-
 ing Bond, as to lost City Warrants Nos 44 & 46
 No 44, issued June 6th 1899 to L. E. L. & W. Co for
 \$42.50 and #45 issued June 6th 1899 to L. E. L. & W. Co,
 for \$50.00. The petition asked for issue of

duplicate City Warrants as shown and named
 above, On motion the petition of L. Foley
 was adopted and the City Recorder ordered to
 issue duplicate warrants as asked for in
 said petition, and to place Bond on file.

On motion City Recorder was instructed
 to Post the usual City Election Notices as
 provided for by Ordinance.

The following named persons were
 nominated and elected to act as Judges of
 the coming City Election to be held on
 the first Monday in Dec, being the 3rd
 day of December 1900.

Hon. C. B. Montague J. G. Reed and J. M. Burtenshaw.

A. O. Sturm and S. O. Wallace were
 nominated and elected to serve as Clerks of
 said Election.
