

Lebanon, Or., Nov. 5<sup>th</sup> 1901  
 Council Called to Order by Mayor M.A. Miller

Roll Call showed all Councilmen present except W.B. Donaca; City Recorder, Treasurer, & Marshal were also present.

Minutes of previous meeting read and approved.

On motion the City Marshal was instructed to ratify Jerome Smith to build new sidewalk abutting his Lots on second street between Maple and Grant streets in the City of Lebanon, Or.

On motion the City Council proceeded to elect 3 Judges and 2 Clerks for the coming election to be held on Dec. 2<sup>nd</sup> 1901. S.O. Wallace, D.W. Hardin, and A. Parrish were elected Judges and J. B. Boyle and Geo. W. Rice Clerks, of said election.

City Recorder was instructed to Post the usual notices of coming City Election also to issue Certificates of Election to Judges and Clerks of Election.

On motion the question shall come run at large within the city limits, was decided on to leave the question to the legal voters of the City at the coming election.

L. Faley, City Treasurer made verbal report as to the amount of money received and disbursed by him.

On motion the Rules were suspended and the following Bill allowed.
