

Lebanon, Or., Dec. 17<sup>th</sup> 1901  
 Council called to order by W. A. Miller Mayor  
 Roll call showed all Councilmen  
 present except W. B. Donaca Recorder &  
 City Marshal were also present.

Minutes of previous meeting read  
 and approved.

Committee on streets and  
 Public Property, asked for further  
 time to report on the Vacation Petition  
 of P. M. Scraggin they also asked for  
 further time to report on Foot Bridge  
 across the Lebanon and Santiam Canal Tail  
 Race, as referred to Committee some time  
 since. There being no objections the  
 Committee was granted further time to  
 make reports as to Vacation and Foot  
 bridge.

Mayor & Recorder filed their  
 Report as canvassers of the City Election  
 held on Dec. 2<sup>nd</sup> 1901, showing that  
 A. M. Wilson was Elected Mayor  
 for Two Years, and  
 J. E. Ducks, B. A. Millkap and  
 Geo. Buhl Councilmen for Two Years  
 and J. M. Burtinshaw, Ernest Lindley  
 and J. D. Smith for One Year,  
 and W. C. Peterson City Recorder for  
 One Year, and  
 Geo. Alexander City Treasurer  
 for One Year, and  
 Phillip Ritter City Marshal for  
 One Year, (and that cows may run  
 at large).

On motion the report of the  
 Mayor and Recorder as canvassers of  
 the Votes of the City Election was

approved and the City Recorder instructed to issue the Certificates of Election as provided for by Ordinance to the Late Elected City Officers and Councilmen.

City Recorder reported that J. S. Compton had been appointed Deputy City Marshal, by Philip Ritter City Marshal.

On motion the appointment of J. S. Compton was confirmed and approved by the City Council.

On Motion the City Council decided that they would allow J. S. Compton \$1.25 per day for his services while watching the City against Contagious Disease under the instruction of the City Marshal and City Council.

On motion the rules were suspended and the following Bill allowed:
