Council Called to Order by Mayor A. M. Wilson

Roll Call showed all Councilmen and other City officials present except City Attorney

Minutes of previous meeting left 2nd read and approved as read,

Report of City Treasurer for 3rd quarter Read and ordered placed on file

City Recorder asked for further time to make report, which was granted.

The following Resolution was presented and read by the City Recorder,

Whereas, it is for the best interest of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, that the said City sell and convey the vacant lot now owned by said City and described as follows, to-wit:-

Lot Three in Block Twenty in Kalliton's Second Addition to Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, and whereas L. M. Jones has made a bonafied offer to said City of One Hundred and twenty five dollars in cash for said lot, which said offer is a fair and just valuation thereof,

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the said City accept, and the said City does hereby accept, said offer of said L. M. Jones of One Hundred and Twenty five Dollars for said lot, and that the Mayor and the Recorder of said City be and they are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to execute and deliver unto said L. M. Jones a good and sufficient deed to said lot upon the payment by said L. M. Jones of the sum of One Hundred and twenty five

Dollars to the Treasurer of said City, said
 deed to be so executed and delivered for
 and in behalf of the said City,

The Bell Tower was reported as in
 a dangerous condition.

On motion the Mayor appointed
 the entire Council as a committee of the
 whole with power to act, as they see
 best as to the advisability of repairing

on buying a New Bell Tower,

 City Treasurer to pay same,
