Lebanon Or. Oct 21-1902

Council Called to Order by Councilman Geo. Buhl, and in absence of Mayor Wilson on motion duly made and carried J. E. Ducks was chosen Mayor pro tem for the evening. Roll Call showed all Councilmen and City Officers present except Mayor Wilson and City Treasurer G. L. Alexander.

Minutes of Oct 17th read and approved. Committee on Health & Police, made verbal report as to their findings as to the tile in slough across the premises of W. M. Brown, Kile and others, and reported that the said tile was on private property and that the City was in no wise under obligations to the property owners to repair or fix the same.

On Motion duly made and carried the following Resolution was duly made and passed by the City Council.

Whereas, the following named persons have failed, refused and neglected to build sidewalks on the property, by them owned, and described in Resolution and Order of the City Council of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, providing for the building thereof, within the time therein specified; which said persons and said property are more particularly described as follows, to-wit:-

of Second Street, abutting Lot 8 Block 2,
Original Town of Lebanon, Owned by
S. M. W. Hindman and Fannie E. Hindman

West side of Second Street abutting
Lots 1 & 2, Block 9, Original Town of
Lebanon, Owned by C. B. Chandler,

West side of Second Street, abutting
Lots 3 & 4, Block 9, Original Town of
Lebanon, Owned by D. T. Pitchford

East side of Second Street, abutting
Lots 5 & 6, Block 15 Ralston's 2nd Addition
Owned by Mary Bryant.

East side of Main Street, abutting
Lots 4 & 5, Block One Kirkpatrick's
Second Addition Owned by D. C. Holt

East side of Main Street

Now, therefore, be it resolved, that the side-
walks hereinabove described be built,

without delay, under the supervision of
the Street Commissioners, and that there
be assessed upon each lot or part
thereof liable therefor its proportionate share
of the cost thereof, as provided by the Charter
& Ordinances of said City.
