

Council Meeting at Council Chamber,
Lebanon, O., Nov. 4th 1902
Council called to order by Mayor A. M. Wilson,

All Councilmen present except J. E. Dwyer

City Marshal,

Minutes of previous meeting read

Committee of the whole appointed to
ascertain the advisability of Repairing or
buying New Bell Tower, Reported that
M. Dehell, L. & Staver Co, through their Agt,
had made a very liberal offer for Bell
tower for the City,

On motion a special Committee
of three consisting of B. A. Millsaps,
J. M. Burtenshaw and Geo. Buhl were
appointed by the Mayor, with full power
to purchase Bell tower if they see fit to
do, after getting word direct from M. L. & S.
Co. of Cincinnati.

Geo. W. Rice as Judges of the coming Election
to be held Dec 1st 1902, and
W. E. Harder and A. O. Sturm as Clerks
of said Election

Clerks and to post the proper Notices of the
coming Election to be held Dec 1st 1902.
