Lebanon Or. Dec 2nd 1902
Council called to order by T. B. A. Millage
and in absence of the Mayor, Councilman
J. B. Brooks was chosen mayor Protem
for the evening

Roll call showed Councilmen and officers
present except Mayor Wilson, and City Treasurer
and City Attorney,

Minutes of previous meeting read
and approved

City Marshal reported that he had
considerable new sidewalk work ordered by the
City and that he would complete S. M. St.
Hinchman and Francis E. Hinchman walk at
once,

City Recorder reported that he had
investigated as to the amount of rent due
from the F. O. R. and he found the Order
had paid Hall rent up to Jan 1st 1901
and at the rate which the Order had been
paying there would be due the City \$8⁰⁰
up to Jan 1st 1903

On motion the City Recorder was
instructed to Present Bill to the F. O. R. and
notify them that if they wished to occupy
the City Hall they would be required to
contract with the City Council for the
same, at such price as could be agreed
upon,

J. B. Hoopes asked the City Council
to have Ordinance 54, Sec 18 amended so
as to read \$500 per Quarter instead of
Twenty five Dollars, (The same being
concerning Licensing Steaming Pin Key,

On motion the Ordinance Committee
was instructed to have amendment
prepared to Ordinance #54 Sec 18 to read

Seven and 5/100 Dollars per Quarter
 provided J. B. Haper would ~~accept~~ accept
 and pay for the amendment as the passage
 and making of the same might cost.

The Committee of Accounts and
 Current Expenses reported favorable on the
 following Bill which was by Motion
 allowed and warrants ordered drawn on
 the City Treasurer to pay same
