Whereas, the total costs of the improvements heretofore ordered to be made and which have been made by the City at the expense of the owners of the lots abutting thereon, to-wit:

The construction of the sidewalk on the following described real property, Standing in the name of S. M. W. Hindman and Fannie E. Hindman, to-wit: north side of maple street, and east side of second street, abutting Lot 8, Block

Two. Original Town of Lebanon, owned by S. M. W. Hindman and Fannie C. Hindman
 And the construction of the sidewalk on the following described real property, ~~standing~~ in the name of J. P. Wallace to-wit: - South side of Grant street, abutting Lot 1, Block 3, J. M. Ralston 4th addition, owned by J. P. Wallace, have been ascertained and audited and found to be \$33,18
