

Lebanon Or. Aug. 18th 1903
 Council Called to Order by Mayor A. M. Wilson
 Roll call showed all Councilmen and
 City Officers Present Except Councilman
 Geo. Buhe and Ed. Kellenburger, and City Treas-
 and City Attorney,

Minutes of Aug 11th 1903 and Aug.
 12, 13, & 14th 1903 read and approved,

On motion the City Recorder was
 instructed to Notify the Pacific States Tel. &
 Tel. Co. to Paint its Poles as agreed to by
 Mr. Waller when erecting the same,
 on main street, between Ash and Grant
 Streets,

On Motion the following Resolution
 was adopted:-

"Resolution Concerning Taxes"
 Council Chamber Lebanon Lin Co, Oregon,-
 Aug 18th 1903

Whereas it is necessary that money be raised by
 taxation for the general expense of the City of
 Lebanon Lin County Oregon and likewise for
 the improvement construction and repair of the
 roads and streets of said City

Now therefore be it Resolved:-

That the Council of said City in regular meeting
 assembled on this 18th day of August 1903,
 do hereby, Vote and make a levy of six
 mills on One dollar for general City purposes,
 and the further levy of One and One half
 mills on the dollar for road and street
 purposes, on all the property within
 said City by law assessable upon the
 valuation of such property as shown by
 the assessment roll for 1903,

now on file in the office of the
 City Recorder of said City-

and further, that the City Council of aforesaid do hereby Vote and make a levy of the sum of Two Dollars upon each male inhabitant of Said City, between the age of Twenty One and fifty years, except those exempt by Law.

On Motion the City Recorder was instructed to complete the Tax roll by checking and figuring the same up in accordance with the foregoing Resolution and when complete to turn the same over to the City Treasurer for Collection,

The following Bill having been O. K. by the Committee on A/C and Current Expenses, were read and on motion allowed and Warrants ordered drawn on City Treasurer to pay same,
