Lebanon Or. Sept. 21<sup>st</sup> 1903  
Council Called to order by Mayor A. M. Wilson  
pursuant to adjournment of Sept. 15<sup>th</sup> and Sept.  
18<sup>th</sup> 1903.

Roll call showed all Councilmen Present  
except Geo. Louell, other City Officers were  
Present except City Treasurer.

Minutes of previous meeting read and  
approved.

Committee on streets and Public  
property asked for further time to report on  
as to A. P. Blackburns walk, as asked for by  
L. J. Peterson.

Letter from J. H. Thatcher Mgr. P. S. Tel. Hel. Co.  
to City Attorney read and City Attorney instructed  
to draft Ordinance calling for the Co. to  
Paint Poles those already up and those to be  
put up in City Limits, and franchise to  
read for the term of five years, Company  
to furnish free Phone at City Hall.

City Marshal C. R. Lovell tendered his  
resignation as City Marshal on account  
of his wifes sickness, and his business  
affairs outside the City Limits.

On Motion the Resignation of C. R. Lovell  
as City Marshal was accepted.

Whereupon the City Council proceed to the  
Election of a City Marshal to fill the  
unexpired term caused by the resignation  
of C. R. Lovell.

Mayor declared Nominations in order  
for City Marshal

J. B. A. Millsap Nominated L. J. Peterson  
for City Marshal.

There being no further nomination the  
Mayor declared the Nominations closed,  
and instructed the City Recorder to

as to Vote for City Marshal  
 The Mayor stated those of the City Council  
 favoring L. J. Peterson for City Marshal  
 will signify the same by saying Yes those  
 opposed No.

The Mayor stated that L. J. Peterson having

 Retail Liquor License to J. S. Warwick  
 and G. B. Hansard, as provided for by Ordinance.

 were read and on motion allowed and warrants  
 ordered drawn on City Treasurer to pay same  
 General Fund.
