and City officers Present.Minutes of previous Meeting
read and approved.It being the time to elect Judges
and Clerks for the coming City Election
the Mayor declared Nominations for same
in order.B. Burtenshaw, S. O. Wallace and
J. M. Stokes were nominated and
duly elected to serve as Judges of said
Electionsand Geo. Crason and Geo. Randall
was elected to serve as Clerks of
Elections.The question as to the proficiency
of the Waterworks was discussed and
the Mayor appointed a special committee
consisting of Geo. Buhl and Geo. Louchee
to investigate as to the proficiency of the
Same.City Treasurer turned in the delinque-
nt tax lists for the years 1899, 1900,
1901 and 1902. On motion the
delinquent tax list was ordered turned
over to the City Marshal with instri-
ctions to collect the same so far as possible.
The Bill of Powers and Laftin was
disallowed, and the Bill of S. J. Peterson
for \$2.00 for night watching was left over.
Still next regular meeting and the following
Bill having been O. K. by the Committee
on a/c and current Expenses was
allowed and warrants ordered thereon.
