Council called to order by Mayor A. M. Wilson

Roll call showed all City officers and Council present, except Councilmen C. Postlar and City Attorney S. M. Garland.

Minutes read and approved

Ordinance Committee reported that they had conferred with City Attorney as to amendment to Ordinance No 54, as the proposed amendment was not quite clear to all. The Committee asked for further time

WE, A. M. Wilson Mayor and W. C. Peterson, City Recorder Canvassers of the Vote of the City Election of Lebanon, Or. held for the purpose of electing City Officers, and other City Officials held on the 7th day of December A. D. 1903. By leave to report to the City Council of said City that we have canvassed the votes of said Election, as provided for in Ordinance No 16 Sec, No 16 of the same. WE find that the Number of Votes Cast was 234 and that for Mayor to serve two years B. Burtenshaw received 226 Votes

Hope City Marshal, to serve one year each, and B. A. Millsap, J. B. Springer, and A. M. Wilson, Councilmen to serve two years each.

On Motion the report of the Mayor and Recorder as commissioners of the last city election was approved and the City Recorder instructed to issue Certificate of Election to the New City official Board.

J. S. Hughes asked through B. A. Millsap the privilege of extending his Light Station West into the street.

On Motion the Committee on streets and Public Property were empowered to investigate as to the extension asked for by Mr. Hughes and if in their opinion the same would not in any wise interfere with the street and would be practical grant the privilege for said extension.

Board of Trade and Luke Jennings for Retail Liquor License was presented and read and on Motion approved and City Recorder instructed to issue License on Circulation of Receipts from City Treasurer for Money for said License.

The following Bill having been O.K. by the Committee on accounts current business were read and on Motion allowed and Warrants ordered drawn on City Treasurer to pay same.
