

## City Council Chamber

Lebanon Or. Aug 16<sup>th</sup> 1904  
 Council called to order by Mayor B. Burtenshaw  
 Roll call showed all City officials  
 present except Councilman Kellenberger  
 and City Treasurer Alexander,  
 Minutes of previous meeting read and  
 approved.

Under the head of reports of city officers  
 City Marshal reported that there was considerable  
 disturbance on the night of Aug 13<sup>th</sup> 1904  
 in the dwelling occupied by Reed and  
 Hugh Bryant,

City Marshal was instructed to  
 get all the evidence possible and file  
 complaint so far as he and City attorney  
 deemed advisable.

On motion duly made and carried  
 the City attorney and Ordinance  
 Committee were instructed to prepare  
 a Fire Limit Ordinance also an ordin-  
 ance compelling the building of Cement  
 side walks in certain parts of the City,  
 and to submit the same to the City Council  
 for action on same.

On motion the Cuddy store occupied by  
 Hutchins was declared a public  
 nuisance and Mayor B. Burtenshaw  
 was instructed to notify the Proprietor  
 that if the same was not conducted better  
 they would be compelled to close the  
 same. Chief of Fire department stated  
 that Cart No 2 was without a house in  
 the Business part of the City. On motion the  
 Commission on Streets & Public Property was  
 instructed to have New House House  
 built, and A. M. Wilson was appoin-  
 ted as a committee of one to see

Trustees of the I. O. O. F. and see if Court  
house could be set on I. O. O. F. Lot on  
Main street.

The following Bills having been  
O. K. by Committee on accounts and  
current Expenses, were read and on  
Motion allowed and warrant ordered  
drawn on City Treasurer to pay same  
Road and Street Fund.
