Lebanon Or, Oct. 5th 1904

Council Called to Order by Mayor B. Bartwick
 and in pursuance of adjournment of
 Oct. 4th 1904

Roll call showed all city officials
 present except Councilman J. B. Springer
 Minutes of Sept 20th and Oct 4th 1904
 read and approved.

Committee appointed to wait on the
 L. C. L. & M Co. as to Fire service
 reported verbally that they had conferred with
 J. S. Hughes Mgr. of the Co. and that he
 claimed the Co. could throw more water
 at present than when contract was made
 with the City.

Report of the City Treasurer, also the
 Report of the City Recorder was read
 and on motion referred to the committee
 on accounts and current expenses.

Ordinance No 62 was presented by
 Ordinance Committee, which was
 read first time by direction of the
 Mayor.

There being no objections offered upon
 the first reading of the Bill

The Mayor stated that the Bill might
 be read the second time now by title only.
 By unanimous consent,

Upon the question, shall the Bill be
 read second time by title only,
